




a and an




Let's compare a and an

A girl




We also use a before "u" and "eu"

We use an before words which begin




An apple



We usually use a/an with a noun to talk about a person or thing for the first time.

➤ We usually use *the* when we talk about the person or thing again

This *a* girl. *The* girl's name is Aidana. She is 12 years old. I know *the* girl from her childhood. Aidana is very nice girl.
